The public is reminded that a defendant is presumed innocent. This information contains only charges and is not proof of the defendant's guilt.

After an extensive investigation by the Carlinville Police Department with support from the South Central Illinois Drug Task Force members, Illinois State Police, Macoupin County Sheriff's Department and the Girard Canine Unit, formal charges of 9 counts of Residential Burglary have been filed by Macoupin County States Attorney Jennifer Watson against Christopher J. McDaniels, 19, of Standard City, IL (shown below):



formal charges of 9 counts of Residential Burglary have been filed against Kyle A. Michael, 19, Carlinville (shown below):



and formal charges of 9 counts of Residential Burglary have been filed against a 16 year old juvenile of rural Carlinville.

McDaniels and Michael are currently incarcerated at Macoupin County jail, being held on a \$100,000 bond and the juvenile is being held at Madison County Detention Center.
